

Volunteer Information


TCOTC depends on volunteers to make this a great event. Anyone (whether a TCOTC Member or not) is eligible to help at the trial and no experience is necessary.

Information For Exhibitors

<u>Food</u>: Food will <u>not</u> available for workers only at these trials. There are several restaurants around the show site.

<u>Obstacles</u>: Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

<u>Warm-Ups</u>: A warm-up area in the Star Room, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Ringside: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

<u>Dogs Eligible to Enter</u>: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or register able breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

<u>Height Divisions</u>: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

Regular Titling Classes:

8 Inches—For Dogs 11 Inches and under at the withers.

12Inches—For Dogs 14 Inches and under at the withers.

16 Inches—For Dogs 18 Inches and under at the withers.

20 Inches—For Dogs 22 Inches and under at the withers.

24 Inches—For Dogs over 22 Inches at the withers.

26 Inches—May Be Entered at Owner's discretion.

Preferred Titling Classes:

4 Inches—For Dogs 11 Inches and under at the withers.

8 Inches—For Dogs 14 Inches and under at the withers.

12Inches—For Dogs 18 Inches and under at the withers.

16 Inches—For Dogs 22 Inches and under at the withers.

20 Inches—For Dogs over 22 Inches at the withers.

<u>Prize and Awards</u>: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard and Jumpers with Weaves class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning MACH/PACH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

Information For Exhibitors Cont.

Refunds: A veterinarian certificate *may be required* for females that come into season or ill and injured dogs after the closing date. In this situation, entry fees will be refunded for the weekend (minus a \$ 15.00 administrative fee per day). A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$ 5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

<u>Safety/Behavior</u>: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rule and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are fee of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when using the warm-up jump.

<u>Liability</u>: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitors whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The <u>Twin Cities Obed. Training Club (TCOTC)</u> and its agents, employees, ect. will not assume responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

<u>Crating:</u> There is ample crating and chair space in the ring room. Bring as many crates as you want! No crates or personal chairs in the annex, kitchen, or Star Room. Spectator seating will provided in the annex. Crates may be left overnight; however <u>Twin Cities Obed. Training Club</u> (TCOTC) will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

<u>Annex Line-Up Area</u>: Please help us keep the gate area in the annex clear of congestion and potentially undesirable dog-to-dog interactions. It is a very close quarters area and should only contain dogs that are running or getting in the queue to run.

Entry Fees: Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts or with international money orders payable in US funds.

Online Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through <u>LabTestedOnline.com</u>. All entries submitted online will be accepted until the draw closes. After the draw is completed, if there are runs available, the Trial Secretary will have the option to continue to accept entries online. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Toys are allowed in the ring

Toys must be non-audible

Toys may not leave the handler's hand

Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
